## **Field Rules**

**No Alcoholic Beverages are permitted at the field**

**All pilots must have a current A.M.A. membership card.**

**Turn on transmitter only after obtaining the correct frequency pin.**

**All transmitters must have the correct frequency flag.**

**Keep all equipment in the designated pit area.**

**Fly only from the designated flight line.**

**Do not fly behind the flight line or over the spectator areas.**

**Do not "break-in" engines within hearing distance of the flight line.**

**Closed front-end expansion-type mufflers are required on all engines of .10 cubic inches and over.**

**Aircraft on landing approach have priority over all others.**

**Take-offs and landings will be in one direction only; determined by wind and/or field conditions.**

**Aerobatics will not be permitted over the runway, landing approach, and take-off areas.**

**Pattern practicing will be permitted in designated areas only.**

**Trash policing and control is the duty of every club member.**

**The last person leaving the field has the responsibility of securing the field and gate (if applicable).**

**It is the duty of every club member to not only obey but to enforce the field rules.**
